The Gastro Intestinal Confluent font, which is spooky and tall, was a follow-up to an original Gastro Intestinal font released in December 2000. I didn't like the original because it wasn't "solid" enough – too thin and not very legible. Eventually, after making this version in January 2001, I pulled the original altogether.

According to my early notes on the font, "I got the name from an anatomy poster on my wall, titled 'Motility and the Gastro-Intestinal Tract.' It's kinda gross (the poster.)" Who knew?

This is a DEMO version of the font.

It includes only uppercase and lowercase letters.

You can use the demo version for personal use.

My demo fonts may be distributed through any media, as long as this PDF file is included, you are not selling the fonts, and you don't claim them as your own.
